### Active Minds® Presents Sand Creek Massacre - Wednesday, November 10, 2021 - 3:00PM

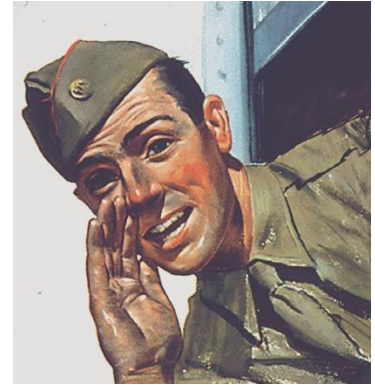
